Resilient Opportunity Zones Program – Building infrastructure resilience in opportunity zones by leveraging public and private funding.

Home & Property Resilience Program – Leveraging public and private funding to support low-cost, effective retrofitting of homes and implementing home-based resilience projects.

Equitable Mitigation Project Design – Developing and implementing mitigation projects in communities of color and low-income communities with the aim of enhancing individual and community resilience. Projects are consistent with FEMA’s benefit cost analysis requirement.

Diversity, Inclusion and Equity Plan Development and Review – I-DIEM develops comprehensive diversity, inclusion and equity plans for local, state, federal, non-profit, and private emergency management agencies. Plans focus on how to sustainably integrate diversity, inclusion, and equity into every aspect of the organization’s operation. Emergency operations plans, mitigation plans, and after-action reports are reviewed as part of plan development and staff interviews are conducted to gain insight into current DIE practices and programs.

Human Resources Diversity, Inclusion, Recruitment, Retention Planning – I-DIEM assists clients to develop comprehensive plans to recruit, retain, and promote women, people of color, and other represented groups. I-DIEM also supports implementation of strategies outlined in the plans.
